Once again the Warrensburg/Johnson County Emergency Management and the Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) will sponsor an Amateur Radio Technician level course aimed at Public Safety, Public Service personnel and the general public. This is a two day course. These classes are 8 hours of class time with a test session following the end of class on day two. Technician level licensees can operate in any mode on any band from 6 meters and higher in the bands assigned to the Amateur Service.

Amateur Radio has proven itself time and time again when all other communication systems fail because it requires little or no existing infrastructure to operate and can be operational in an “even” environment with limited equipment or power requirements.
